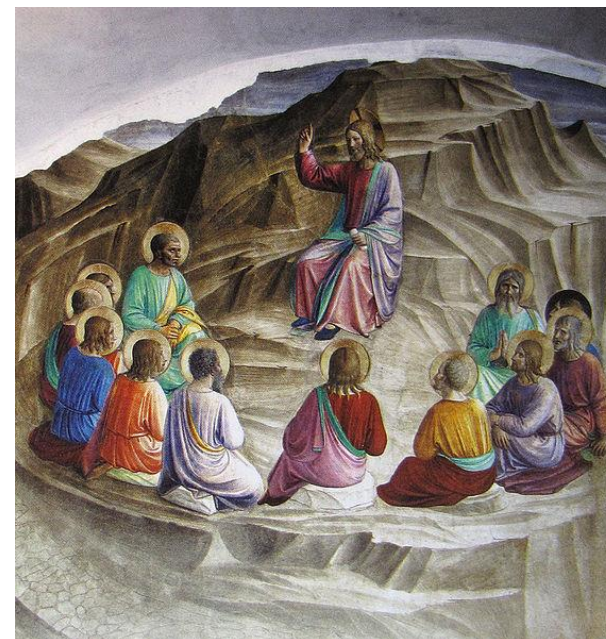

Irish Dancing Classes

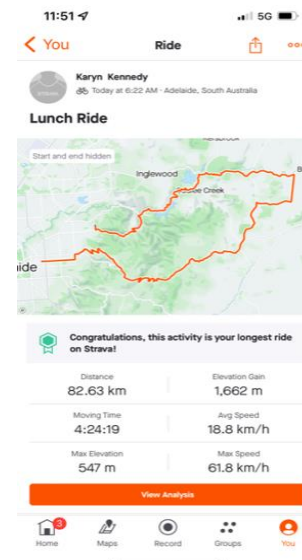
